


Sharks




Dolphins




The Peak Tour



Next, slice the apples into pieces.


Then, roll out one disc of dough into a 12-inch circle. Transfer it to a 9-inch pie plate. Trim the edges to fit the plate.


Next, add the apple filling into the crust and cover it with another disc of dough. Bake for 20 minutes.

My brave dog saved a lady!



- You can season the loaf with a lot of pepper if you wish.




Life then and now

Finally, she lost the competition but her friend praised her creativity.






Feeling sick
