Finally, the bee flies out through the door. I feel happy because we are safe.

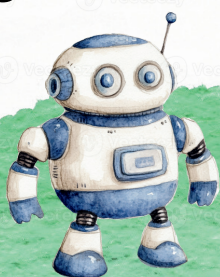


Buying a Present

Just then, Sally's friend Kelly sees her and asks, 'Hey, Sally! What's wrong?'

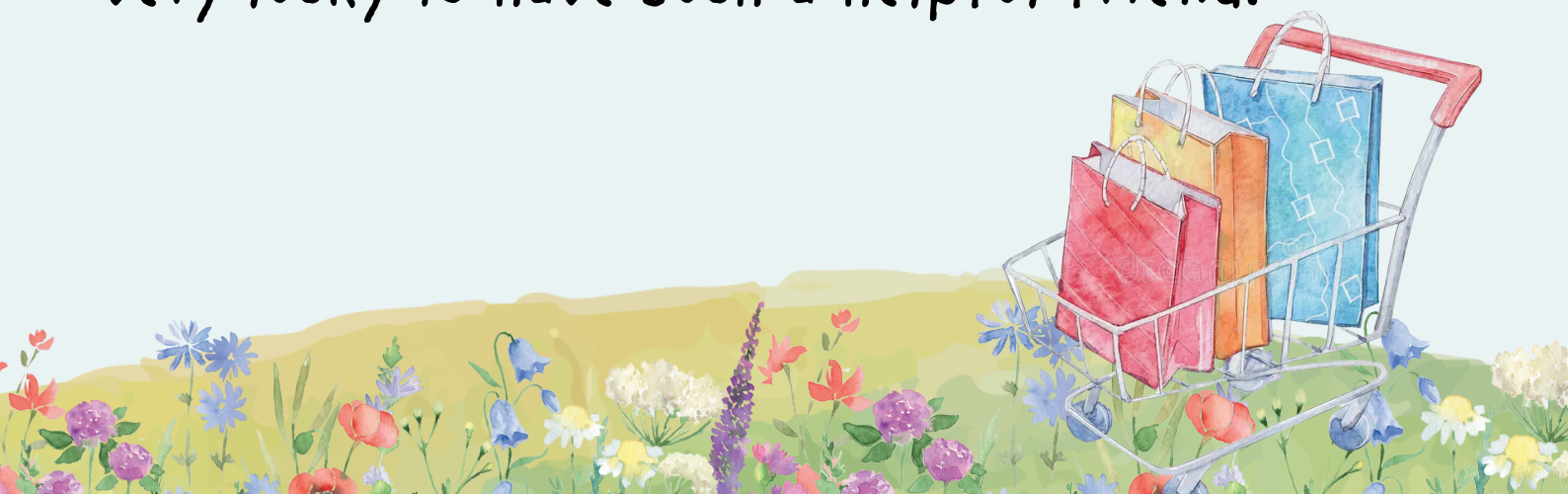
Sally replies, 'I dropped my eggs, and now they're all broken!'

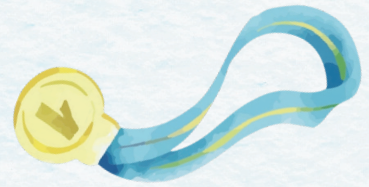

A Person I Admire-Cheung Ka Long Zheng Jiayang, Alan (5A)



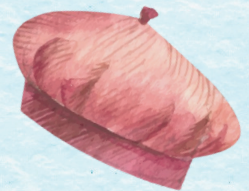
